Your membership is individual. A portion of the annual dues is allocated for a subscription to *Information Outlook*®. No dues are used for lobbying purposes.

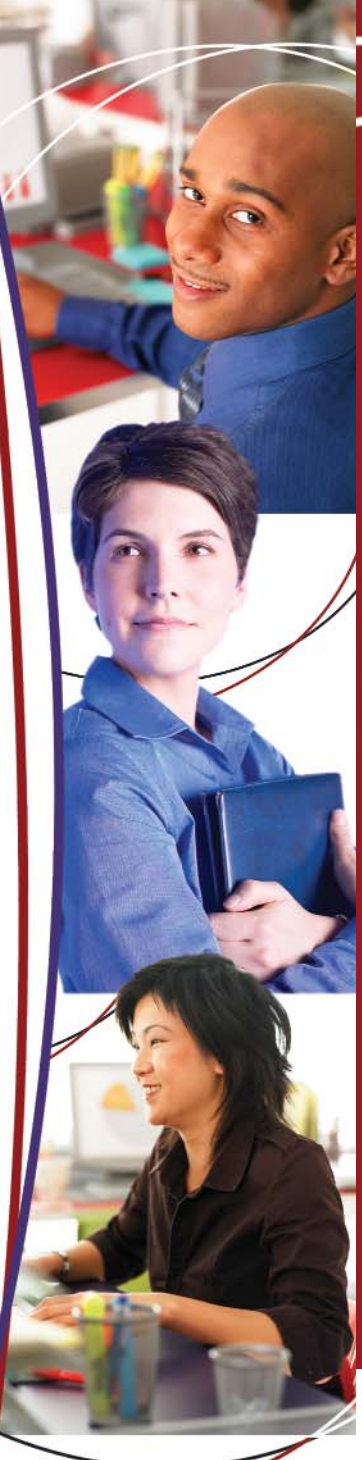
