I am writing this as we approach Halloween and you will be reading it as we approach the December holidays. The year is truly going much too fast!

The program for the annual meeting is progressing satisfactorily and I will write extensively on the details of the program in the February newsletter. For now, however, I will just mention that Ann Campbell has managed to set up a field trip for Wednesday, June 12, to the Southwest Foundation for Biomedical Research in San Antonio. This private, nonprofit foundation houses 3500 nonhuman primates and 4000 animals of other species and is known for its humane treatment of its animals. (Jane Goodale mentions the foundation as a model for animal care.) Animals no longer used for research retire to pleasant quarters and are supported by the invested funds they earned while participating in research - a sort of ape social security. Research areas currently of interest to the foundation include AIDS research, atherosclerosis, osteoporosis, and skin cancer. One of the foundations more important successes is the development of a high frequency ventilation device used for premature infants with hyaline membrane disease. More than 400 infants have been save with this experimental device in the past three years. I hope you will all join us for this field trip. It should prove fascinating! I will have a guided tour probably with lunch on the grounds. Look for details in your preliminary program in

Books in Brief

Adaptation of Turnkey Computer Systems in Sci-Tech Libraries. Ellis Mount, editor. New York: Haworth Press, 1989. 116p. \$22.95. ISBN 0-86656-859-X.

Originally published as an issue of Science & Technology Libraries (v. 9, no. 1, 1988), its purpose is "to deal with the problems and benefits of installing a ready-made computer system in a sci-tech library." The first paper describes a process for selecting a system. The remaining papers provide examples of libraries that have installed Geac, CLSI, NOTIS, and Library Automation Products' "The Assistant."

Healthcare Recruitment Resource Guide. Clearwater, FL: Florida Reference Press, 1989. 473p. \$79.95. ISSN 1046-4603.

This volume "was put together to help hospitals and healthcare facilities find medical professionals more effectively." Professions covered are medical-surgical technologist; nursing; occupational therapy; physicians assistant; pharmacy; physical therapy; respiratory therapy; radiologic technology; and speech pathologist. Each section, arranged by profession, has subsections providing job descriptions; listings of national and state associations; education and training programs; conventions; and publications.

The Role of Conference Literature in Sci-Tech Libraries. Ellis Mount, editor. Binghamton, NY: Haworth Press, 1989. 146p. \$24.95. ISBN 0-86656-780-1.

The aim of this work is "to present a variety of viewpoints on conference literature, including that of librarians, commercial publishers, producers of indexing/abstracting tools, catalogers and editors." A highly useful paper by Nestor L. Osorio provides a tutorial in the use of conference proceedings. Originally published as an issue of Science and Technology Libraries (v. 9, no. 2, Winter 1988).

Sources of Free Materials for Biology Libraries

Many librarians are unaware of the vast number of valuable publications that are available free just for the asking. Over the last several years of doing collection development in the biological sciences, I have built up a large list of government agencies, research institutes, museums, university departments and programs, and even individuals, that are willing to send their publications free of charge. Many of these organizations will put you on a mailing list to receive all new publications automatically or will send you periodic announcements of available items. Publications that can be obtained range from multi-volume monographs, research and technical reports, and serials, in both print and microform format, to pamphlets and offprints suitable for specialized research collections.

What follows is a selected (and in no way systematic) list of names and addresses of organizations that can provide you with valuable resources to enhance a biology collection. Write to them and ask to see a list of available materials and have them place you on their mailing list if they have one.

I have not included agencies of the United States government, since that list alone would be enormous. However, the U.S. Departments of Interior (particularly Fish and Wildlife Service and National Park Service), Agriculture (especially Forest Service), Health and Human Services, Energy, the Environmental Protection Agency, and all of their subordinate branches and units are particularly important in this regard. All issue superb biology publications and will supply them gratis on request. The *Government Research Directory* (5th ed., Detroit: Gale Research, 1989) is a useful resource for addresses and descriptions of research and publications of federal institutions.
